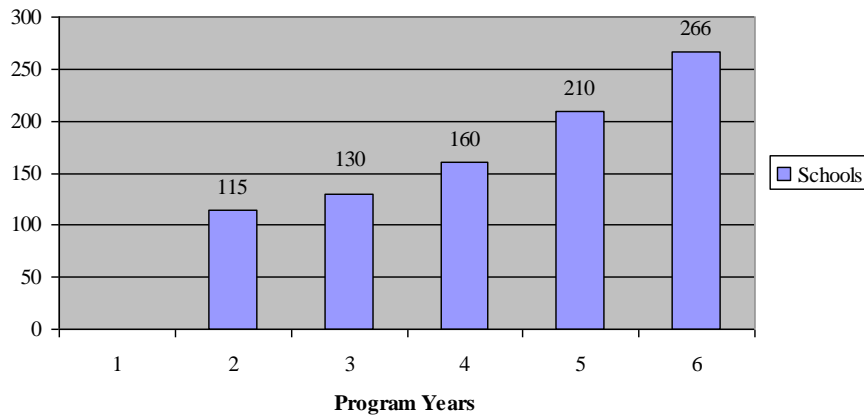
# USDA McGovern-Dole Food for Education Program - Afghanistan

  - Improve the educational infrastructure

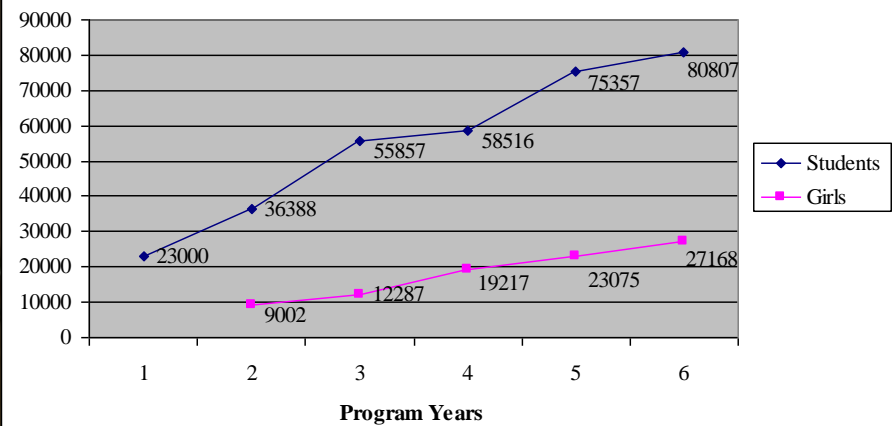


# Increased Enrollment
